

Advice on part-exchanging gaming machines

December 2007

The Commission has been asked to consider whether a supplier's licence to provide a gaming machine in part exchange. The Commission has also been asked whether section 16 or section 21 machines can be part-exchanged.

An operator who provides a gaming machine in part exchange for another gaming machine, which is provided by a licensed supplier of such machines, will not require a supplier's licence or permit. Non-compliant section 16 or section 21 machines can also be part-exchanged.
