Further to your request about enforcement of the Gambling Act 2005, since the Commission's statutory powers came in to force Commission officials have investigated 20 alleged breaches (as defined in my earlier email to you) of which 8 were substantiated. In addition we have another 10 reports which were not considered for investigation. Our published Statement of Principles for Licensing and Regulation outline the Commission's regulatory approach, including our risk-based approach

Please be aware that we do not keep this information separately and it has had to be extracted from other records and may not be 100% complete although, to our recollection, there are no obvious omissions.
