Further to your request to the Gambling Commission (the Commission) under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) for “complaints and queries about the machines in question from the relevant trade bodies, local authorities and its own compliance managers” please see the enclosures provided. In addition to these, supplementary complaints and queries have been made to us orally.

Some of the information in these enclosures has been redacted, either because the information is not relevant to your request or the information is exempt from disclosure. Section 40 of the Act (‘Personal information’) provides that if the information requested constitutes personal data it shall not be disclosed where that disclosure would be in contravention of any of the principles of data protection. The principles of the data protection state that personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and shall not be processed for any purpose other than those for which it was obtained, including disclosure to you.
