1. Improved advice on lotteries

2. Deadline for Section 19 certificate holders almost reached

Time is running out for section 19 certificate holders to ensure they are properly licensed under the Gambling Act 2005. While we are confident that the majority of active Section 19 certificate holders have applied for a personal licence, we suspect a small number of people have yet to do so.

Therefore as a precaution, we have written to casino and bingo operators asking them to ensure that employees who are section 19 certificate holders are aware of the need to apply for a Personal Management Licence or Personal Functional Licence as soon as possible.
