

## Response

Thank you for your request for information below regarding National Lottery winners.

Having completed a check of our records, I can confirm that the Commission does not hold the information you have requested so unfortunately we are unable to help you with this request.

The Commission is responsible for licensing and regulating the National Lottery, ensuring the interests of participants are protected and maximising returns for Good Causes. The Commission has licensed Camelot UK Lotteries Ltd (Camelot) as the operator of the National Lottery.

As the operator, Camelot is responsible for, among other things, the payment of prizes to winners. As such, information regarding jackpot winners is held by Camelot and not the Commission.
