Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
Please find our response below.

It would be disproportionate for us to publically disclose the identity of this individual given their position within the organisations unless there is a strong public interest in doing so. These individuals have a legitimate expectation that their personal details will not be disclosed unnecessarily. The Data Protection Act

1998 requires the processing of personal data to be fair and lawful. On balance, there is no legitimate public interest in disclosing their identity and it would not be fair to do so. This information is therefore exempt under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
